(B) Have you ever gone into a supermarket to buy one thing but end up buying several different things? You might wonder why this happens. It certainly is not by chance. In fact, supermarket operators (經營者) constantly study the consumers' shopping habits and use this information to make people buy more things.

To begin with, supermarket operators usually put the things that people often buy at the back of the stores. Things like milk and eggs are often put at the back so that shoppers have to walk through the whole store. Along the way, shoppers often pick up other things that are not on their shopping lists.
