The disaster, which left 18,500 people dead and the country completely shaken, damaged their house, forcing them to take temporary shelter in government housing. Thankfully, neither Hanyu nor his family were hurt, but vivid memories of the earthquake still haunt him. The event also left him with a greater determination to

make every day count and help the people in need. In splendid fashion, Hanyu has kept his promise to himself and the world. So far, Hanyu has raised money on numerous occasions using ice skating as a method for the people directly affected by the quake and the subsequent tsunami. And this is just one of the many, many things about this star on ice that make a good impression on people at home and abroad.

At 53 kilograms, Hanyu is of relatively slight build. But he is in fact very strong, able to perform jumps, spins and moves that others can only attempt. To achieve such perfection, Hanyu trains constantly and is very demanding of himself. As he glides **effortlessly** across the ice, he sometimes looks more like a ballet dancer than a figure skater. Whenever he's at the rink, he completely enjoys himself, and in return, the audiences love him, responding to his visible joy with cheers and clapping. Often, after Hanyu's performances, people in the crowd shower him with stuffed Pooh Bears, his chosen mascot. In spite of all the wins and the admiration he's received, Hanyu remains humble and humorous. How can anyone not love him?

In modern times, Valentine's Day is a festival of flowers and chocolate, a pleasant time for lovers. No one knows exactly where it all started. Believe it or not, the records show ancient Rome might be a reasonable time to start the festival. Over two thousand years ago, the Romans used to hold an annual festival called Lupercalia from February 13th through February 15th. To pray for having babies, naked Roman men would sacrifice goats and dogs. After removing the skins from the dead animals, they would use these animal skins to whip the naked women around them. The women tolerated and even welcomed all this, believing the gods would fulfill their wishes this way.

Today's celebration is indeed known as Valentine's Day. But who was Valentine? In 269 A.D., a Roman priest named Valentine was put to death because he secretly helped soldiers get married. What he did was illegal in Rome at that time for military reasons. As the story goes, Valentine fell in love with the guard's daughter while he was in prison. Valentine wrote her a goodbye love letter and signed it with the words "From your Valentine" before he was beaten to death on February 14th.

In 496 A.D., to honor Valentine for his great service, Pope Gelasius officially declared the very first St. Valentine's Day to be celebrated on February 14th. Meanwhile, Lupercalia was changed to the feast of St. Valentine, which is commonly thought to be the beginning of today's celebration of Valentine's Day.
