Who Can Build a Better Bot?

Robotics competitions are about more than just robots

Not so long ago, robots existed only in the imaginations of science fiction writers; now they're a normal part of the school curriculum. More and more schools around the world are integrating robotics into their menu of activities. Robotics teams compete in events to show how skillful they can be at making their mechanical inventions come to life. In a way, this trend is only natural: Kids love playing games and engaging in competitions of all sorts. Kids are particularly enamored with video games and technology. 31. Robotics competitions!

Why do many schools recognize the benefits of robotics teams? Naturally, robotics strengthens students' STEM skills (science, technology, engineering and math). Designing robots requires curiosity, logic and critical thinking. There are social benefits as well. When kids work together on a robotics team, it helps them learn about teamwork, collaboration and leadership. 32. In an increasingly high-tech world, robotics prepares kids for the future. And the feeling of accomplishment when they build a working robot — and win in a competition — is incomparable!

Nowadays there are dozens of robotics competitions that are swarming with young robot designers. A quick Google search will uncover more robotics events than you can imagine. 33. Founded by Dean Kamen, FIRST is a program in which experienced mentors guide robotics team members in finding innovative solutions to problems by using robots. Like all

robotics programs, FIRST emphasizes teamwork and building community. One of their core values is the made-up word “coopertition” — a blend of respectful cooperation and intense competition.

Robotics competitions have become a worldwide phenomenon. Nearly a million students and more than 100 countries compete in robotics events through a variety of organizations, such as FIRST, VEX, Botball and RoboCup. At international robotics competitions, teams from around the world match up against each other to compete furiously, but to have fun and form cross-cultural friendships, too. 34. Amazon has grown from an online store that sold mainly books to a digital retail giant where shoppers can buy everything from clothes to kitchen tools. Now, Amazon is making a splash with its new grocery chain, Amazon Go.

Amazon Go offers a unique shopping experience. Before customers can begin shopping, they must first download the Amazon Go app, which is linked to their Amazon.com account. When walking into the store, customers scan their Amazon accounts with their smartphones. From there, they can shop for groceries and other goods.
