I survived the injury, and with my story, the Malala Fund was created to give more power to young girls 9 education. Furthermore, in 2014, I won the Nobel Peace Prize, making me the 10 person ever to receive this great honor. During a speech at the UN, I declared "They [Books and pens] are our most powerful tools. One child, one teacher, one book, and one pen can change the world!"
